Psalm 96

- ¹ Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth.
- ² Sing to the Lord, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day.
- ³ Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples.
- ⁴ For great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; he is to be feared above all gods.
- ⁵ For all the gods of the nations are idols, but the Lord made the heavens.
- ⁶ Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and glory are in his sanctuary.
- ⁷ Ascribe to the Lord, all you families of nations, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.
- 8 Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering and come into his courts.

- ¹³ Let all creation rejoice before the Lord, for he comes, he comes to judge the earth.
- He will judge the world in righteousness and the peoples in his faithfulness.
