Scene #1: Hezekiah's Illness (ch.38-39)

Chapter 38:

V.1-2: Hezekiah becomes ill & will die.
Hezekiah reacts as any of us would (v.2)
Hezekiah's prayer – appeal based on his own actions
V.4-6: God is gracious to answer
God's answer dependent on God's faithfulness, not Hezekiah's actions

& Chapter 39:

Øv.1: Here come the Babylonians
Ø Hezekiah is far too welcoming (v.2)
Ø Hezekiah's folly results in judgment (v.5-8)...
Ø ... And a wretched response reveals Hezekiah's heart (v.8)
Ø This is a conspiracy with consequences

Scene #2: Hezekiah's Faith (ch.36-37)

k Chapter 36:

- Therefore Sennacherib's armies surround Jerusalem (v.1)
- ମ୍ମ Message sent to Hezekiah (v.4-10) ଧ୍ଧ Reliance on Egypt hopeless (v.4-7) ଧ୍ୟ Trusting in God ruled out (v.7)
 - ষHezekiah has no manpower (v.8-9)
 - ষAssyria have a divine mandate (v.10)
- Ø Therefore: Standing firm is useless?
