1 John Key Themes

1 John 1:1 From the Beginning

- In the beginning was the Word
- Beginning with Jesus' birth
- Incarnation Jesus, the God man.
- Twin dangers:
 - Routine
 - Cult of 'newness'

1 John 1:2 Eternal Life Appeared

- ♦ Jesus eternal life appearing
- Seen, heard & touched
- Countering claims that Jesus was just a spirit
- Brining together truth handed down (Scripture) and personal experience

- Practical implications of apostolic testimony:
- 1. Assurance:
