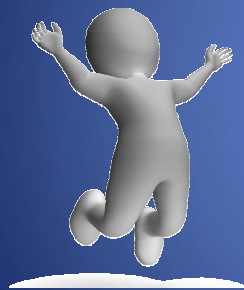

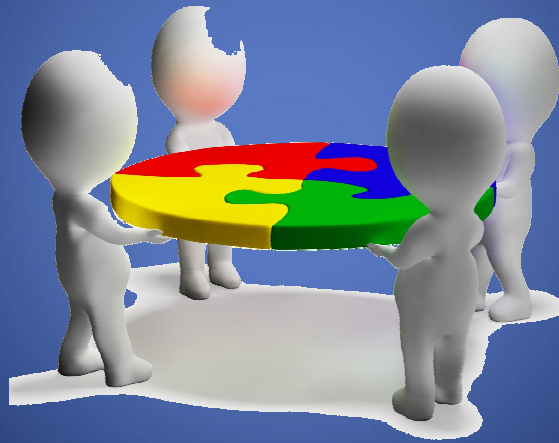
There are different kinds of **GIFTS**, but the same Spirit distributes them.
