# The importance of prayer and obedience.

- 1:35, Jesus shows us the importance of prayer to prepare ourselves.
- 14:35-39, Jesus shows us the importance of praying in the midst of pain and anxieties.
- 6:45, Jesus shows us the importance of prayer in response to and recovery from any action or ministry.

# The importance of prayer and obedience.

- The disciples are obeying what Jesus told them to do when they end up in this storm!
- Have you ever followed God's will and ended in the middle of a storm?
- Our apetite should be to know Jesus more, not to be more comfortable!

### The 'I AM' in the storm

- 1. In the OT only God is supposed to be able to walk on water and make paths through the sea! (Job 9:8, 38:17; Psalm 77:19; Isaiah 43:16)
- 2. Why was Jesus going to pass them by? (Job 9:11; Exodus 33:19+22, 34:6; 1 Kings 19:11)
- 3. 'Fear not I AM who I AM!'
- 4. They could not understand.
