### Job the man

- Job this man was blameless and upright; he feared God and shunned evil. 1v1, 1v8, 2v3
- In all this, Job did not sin by charging God with wrongdoing. 1 v22 2 v10
- Greatest man among the people of the East 1v3
  - Rich & respected
- Suddenly catastrophe comes upon his well-ordered life

## A right perspective on reality

- The spiritual realm is the true reality
  - · God is in charge satan comes to give account
  - Satan is territorial God is omni-present
  - But Job knows nothing about it
    - The world view of his time is one of prosperity theology
    - · His life looks like it has turned into a disaster
    - If we look at this only from the perspective of earth then this is a sick tragedy
  - This is the last mention of satan in the book of Job
