Worship

• Read Psalm 19 together and let it lead you into a time of praise and worship.

Word – Jacob's relationships (Genesis 29:1-30:24)...

Re-cap...

- Relationships have a back-story... hence a need for understanding and tolerance
- Relationships reflect a God-story... hence a need to both give and to receive grace
- Relationships give rise to a still-to-be-written story... hence a reason for hope and an opportunity to leave a legacy
- Conclusion It's not Jacob's story, nor our story, but God's story... Do we want to be in it?

Possible discussion questions (select a few)

- Is it important for us to be able to explain logically things in the Bible which seem implausible? e.g. Jacob only recognising Leah in the morning after his wedding
- Does the passage suggest any elements of strength, as well as strife, in Jacob's relationships?
- To what extent was Jacob's back-story responsible for some of the difficulties in his relationships?
- Are we a product of our own back-stories or, as Christians, are we free from them?
- What cultural elements might we need to be aware of as we seek to engender good relationships with others?
- Do we sometimes use circumstances e.g. pressure at work/tiredness as an excuse for poor behaviour in our relationships? If so, how can we avoid this?
- Do you agree that the way that we treat others is a reflection of our relationship with God? Why/why not? If so, what are the implications of this?
- How do you view the fact that God chose to bless Jacob despite his apparent lack of active personal relationship with God? What does this tell us about God?
- Which are the key elements of our life in Christ that we should seek to bring into our relationships in order to bless others?
- Do you agree that there are elements of God's story that are still to be written?
- What does it mean for us individually and collectively to play a part in God's story?

Prayer and witness

- Pray for God to work powerfully in and through your relationships. Pray for any relationships issues which are currently particularly tough. Pray that our relationships might be a witness to others.
