NMBC Small groups - week beginning 3rd March 2019

Knowing the truth of the Gospel Colossians 1:1-14

Opening meditation:

Give "joyful thanks to the Father" using the key words & truths of 1:12-14.

Ideas for study & discussion. Select 3 or 4 questions you feel most helpful to discuss.

Read 1:1-2

- 1 What's the meaning of the title 'apostle'? You could look at Hebrews 3:1, Luke 6:13, Mark 6:7 & 30.
- 2 Why do you think Paul pointedly said that his ministry was by "the will of God"? To follow up this theme the most helpful place is Galatians 1:1 & 11-12.

Read 1:3-6

- 3 What are the **key characteristics** of the Colossian Christians for which Paul gives thanks? Note similar headline characteristics in 1 Corinthians 13:13; 1 Thessalonians 1:3 & 5:8
- 4 What do we learn about the 'gospel' in these verses?

 Let individuals/pairs separately suggest a sentence to summarise the 'good news'.
- 5 What does 'hope' mean for a Christian? ...in these verses... and in such places as: Titus 1:1-2 & 3:7; 1 Peter 1:3-5

Read 1:7-8

6 Make a summary of the limited but encouraging knowledge we have of **Epaphras**. Here are the only references to him: Colossians 1:7-8; Colossians 4:12; Philemon 1:23

Read 1:9-12

- 7 What are key pointers to assessing the **spirit of our discipleship** in following Christ?
- 8 If we're living out 'good news', why the need for endurance & patience?

Read 1:13-14

- 9 Why does the imagery of 'light' & 'darkness' occur so frequently in the New Testament? Discuss this after asking different members to read out these verses in sequence:

 Matthew 4:16; John 1:4-5; John 3:19; John 12:46; 1 John 1:5-7; 2 Corinthians 4:4-6
- 10 How would you define the 'dominion of darkness' in our own society & culture?
- 11 'Growing' is an emphasis through this letter: see 1:6, 1:10, & 2:19.

 In what ways do we want to grow? Suggest what practical action we aim to take?
