What does the Holy Spirit do?

Living in relationship with God- session 3

Introduction: The Spirit's job description

"His ministry is both to reveal Christ to us, and to form Christ in us" John Stott

 The Spirit brings us to know Jesus in the first place (John 3:1-8, p. 1065)

"When the Spirit comes he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgement" **John 16:8**

 The Spirit brings us into fellowship with Jesus day by day

"And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age" Matthew 28:20

a. He enables us to experience God's love (Romans 5:5-8, p. 1132)

b. He gives us a deep assurance that God is our Father (Rom. 8:15-16, p. 1135)

3. The Spirit changes us to be more like Jesus (2 Corinthians 3:16-18, p. 1160)

4. The Spirit empowers us to be witnesses for Jesus (Acts 1:8, p. 1093)

5. The Spirit equips us to serve Jesus' people (1 Cor 12:4-7, p. 1153)

Conclusion: The spot-light Spirit...

"A church that is filled with the Spirit is a church that is thrilled with Jesus."

- How many contrasts can you find between someone living by the Spirit, and someone living by the sinful nature?
- What future hope do those with the Spirit have? (v9-11) Why?
- What is our 'obligation' as Christians? (v12)
- How does the Spirit help us to experience our relationship with God? (v13-18)
- How does the Spirit help us in our prayer-lives? (v26-27)
